DIRECTIONS



From I-95/MA-128 North or South:

- Take Exit 31B to merge onto MA-225/MA-4N/Bedford St. toward Bedford.
- Drive approximately 1/4 mile, bear right into the jug-handle turn (which will allow you to make a U-turn on Bedford Street).
- Stay in the left lane of the jug handle. Take a left at the light.
- The entrance to Boston Children's at Lexington will be the first driveway on your right after the turn.

Public transportation

Boston Children's at Lexington can be reached by public transportation. Take the MBTA Red Line train to Alewife then take the (Bedford V.A. Hospital—Alewife Station) 62 MBTA bus route. The bus will drop you off across the street from the entrance of the building.
